GENERAL OBSERVATIONS

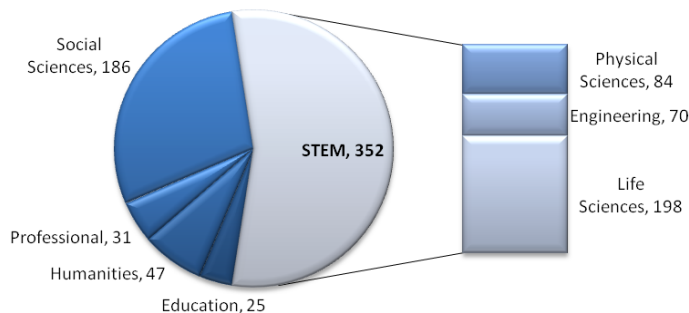
With a total of 639 students, this year's cohort is substantially larger than last year's. Just over half of the students are in STEM disciplines, and 59% of all students expect to graduate in the coming school year. The number of sending (home) institutions is greater than last year. Fewer students originate from CIC universities, but more sending institutions are represented.

Less than half of the cohort is low-income, as indicated by Pell Grant status. McNair Scholars comprise more than a quarter of students, and 11% previously completed an SROP experience.

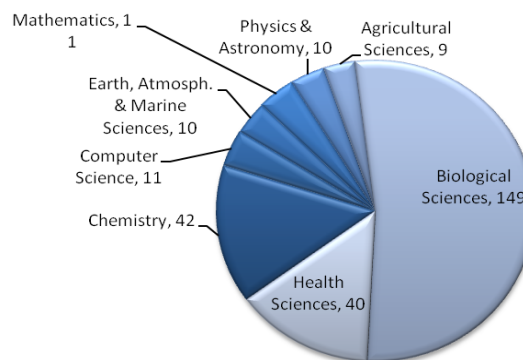

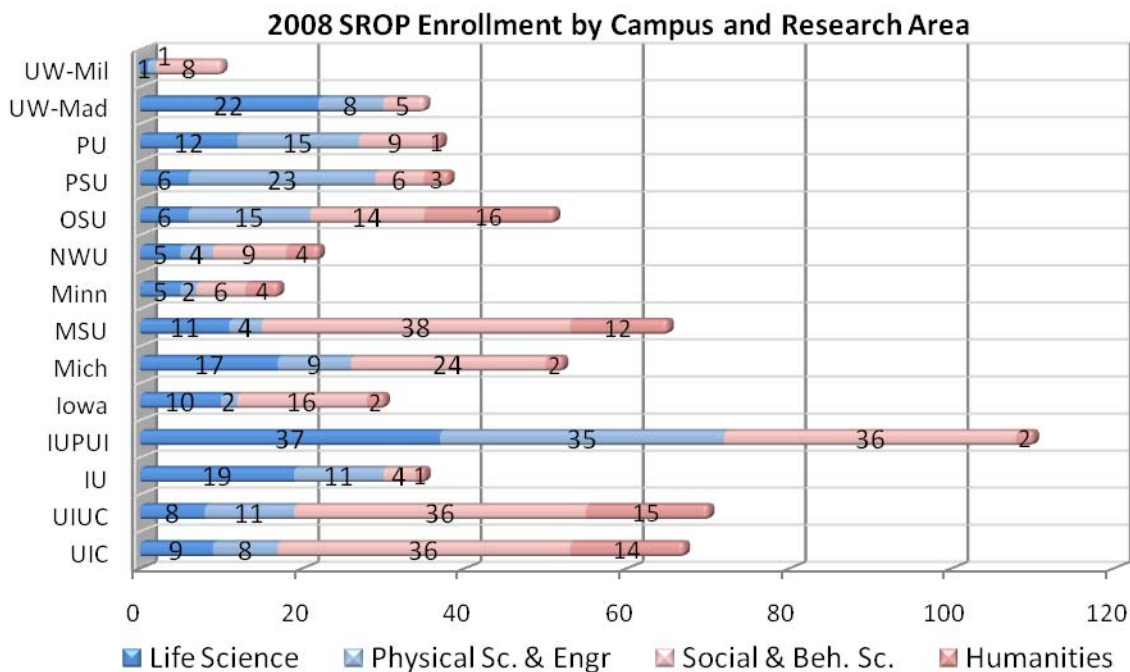

2008 CIC SROP Student Cohort by Major Area of Study



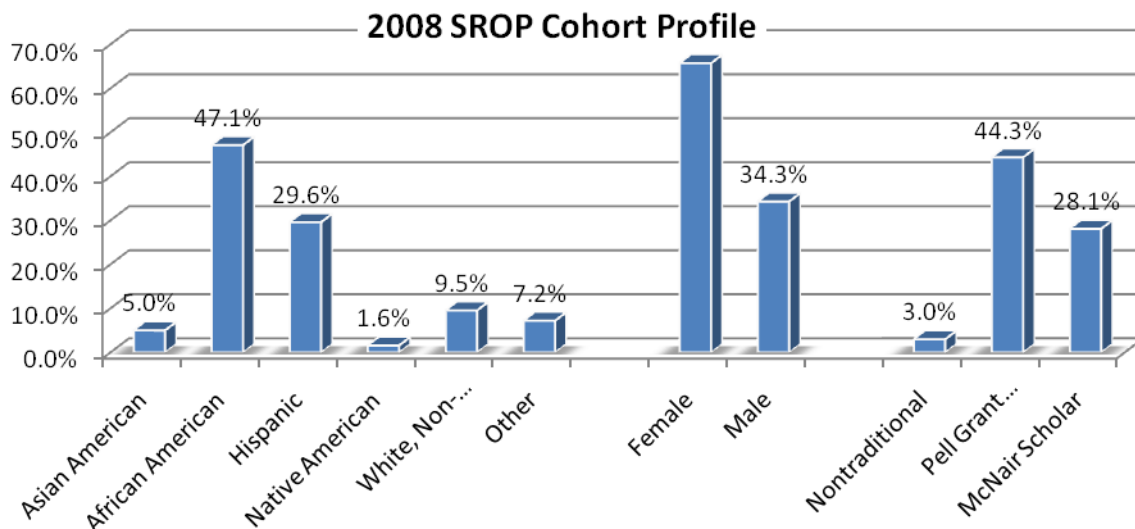
2008 CIC SROP STEM Students by Major Field of Study

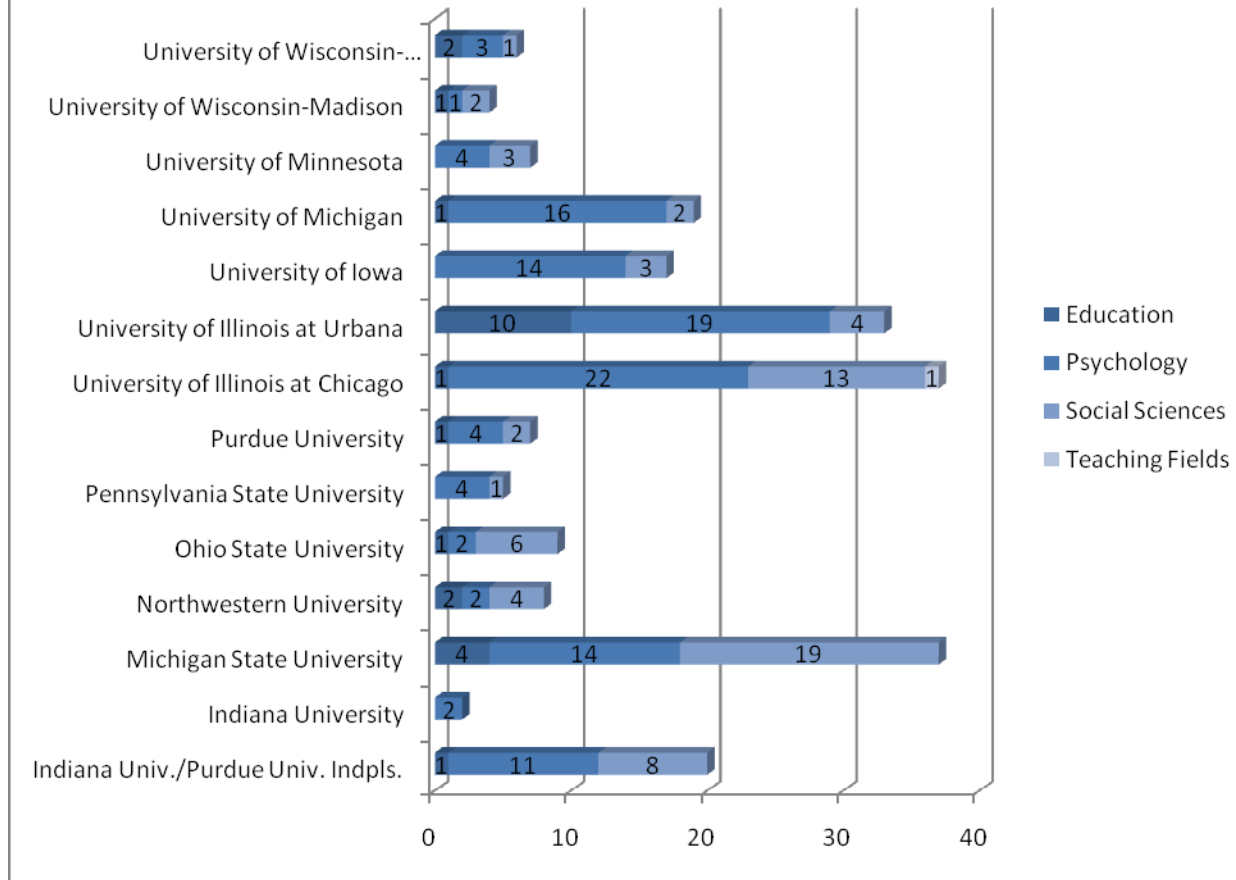
