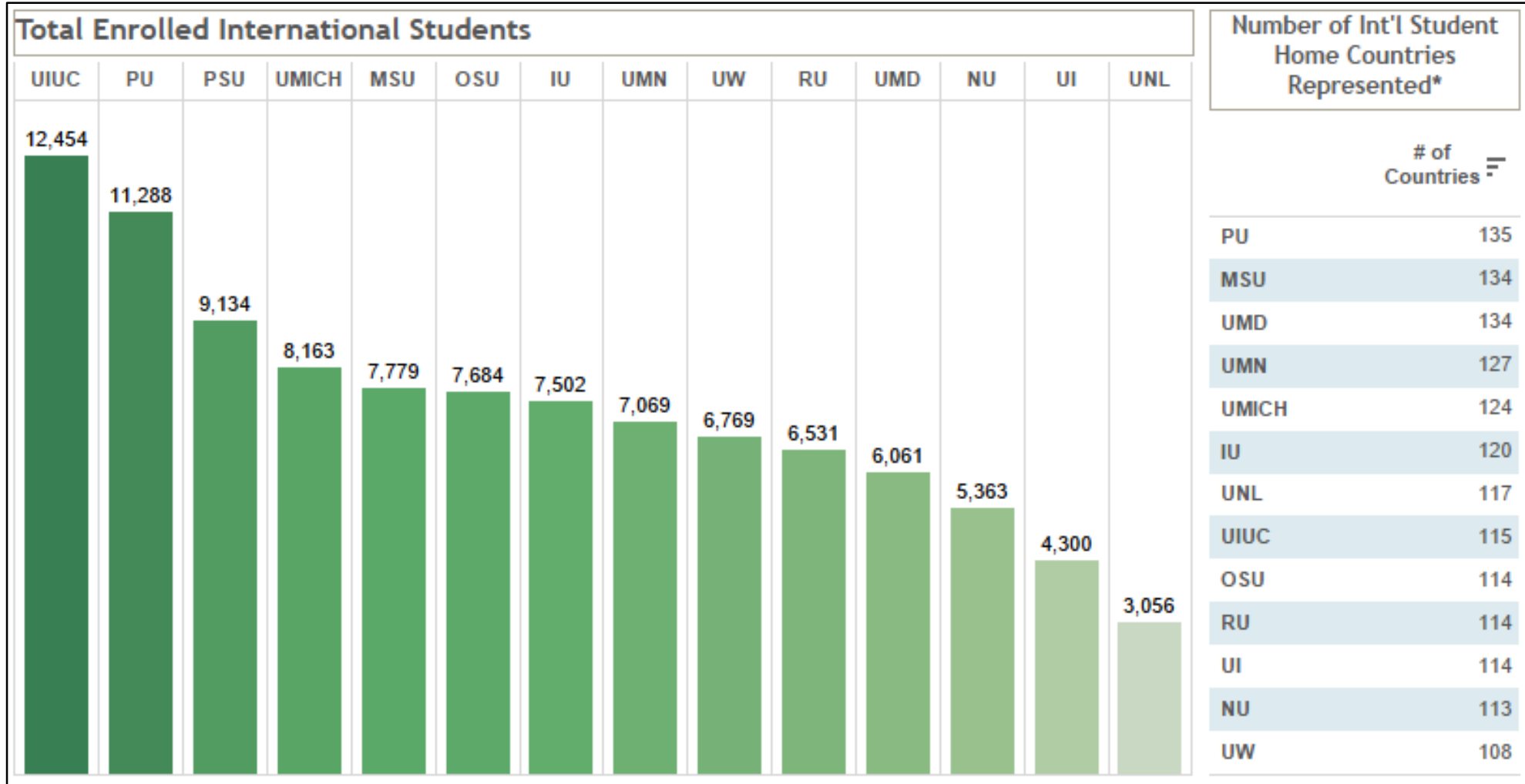
International Student Highlights Fall 2016

- The Top 5 Programs of Study were **engineering, business, computer science, social sciences, and mathematics.**
- The most international students **originated from China, India, and South Korea**, making up over 71% of the total studying at Big Ten Academic Alliance schools.
- About 16.8% of enrolled international graduate students were on **Optional Practical Training (OPT)**, meaning they were authorized for temporary employment authorization that relates to the student's field of study. OPT employment authorization is typically granted for 12 months after the completion of a degree.

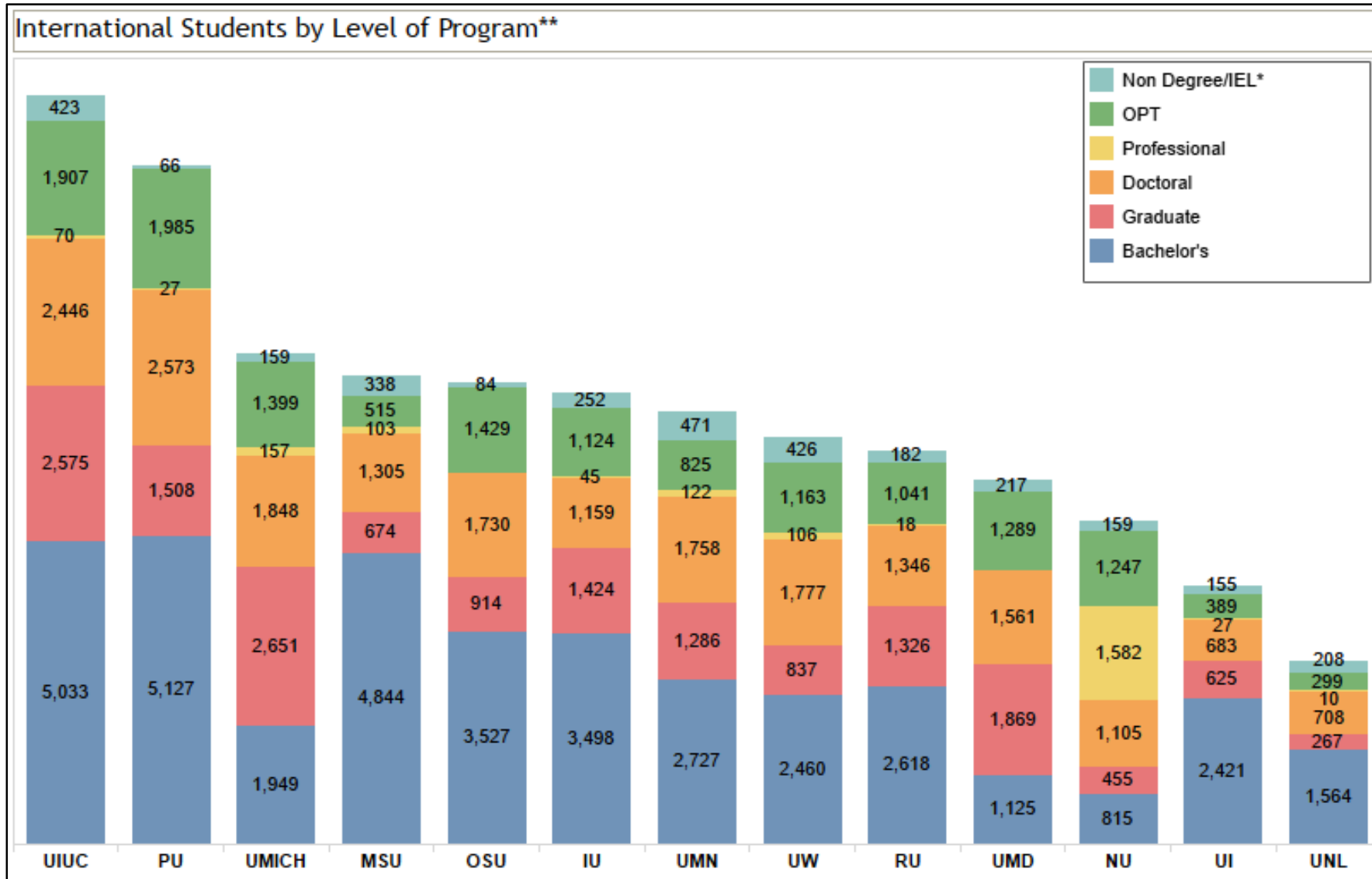
Enrolled International Students Fall 2016

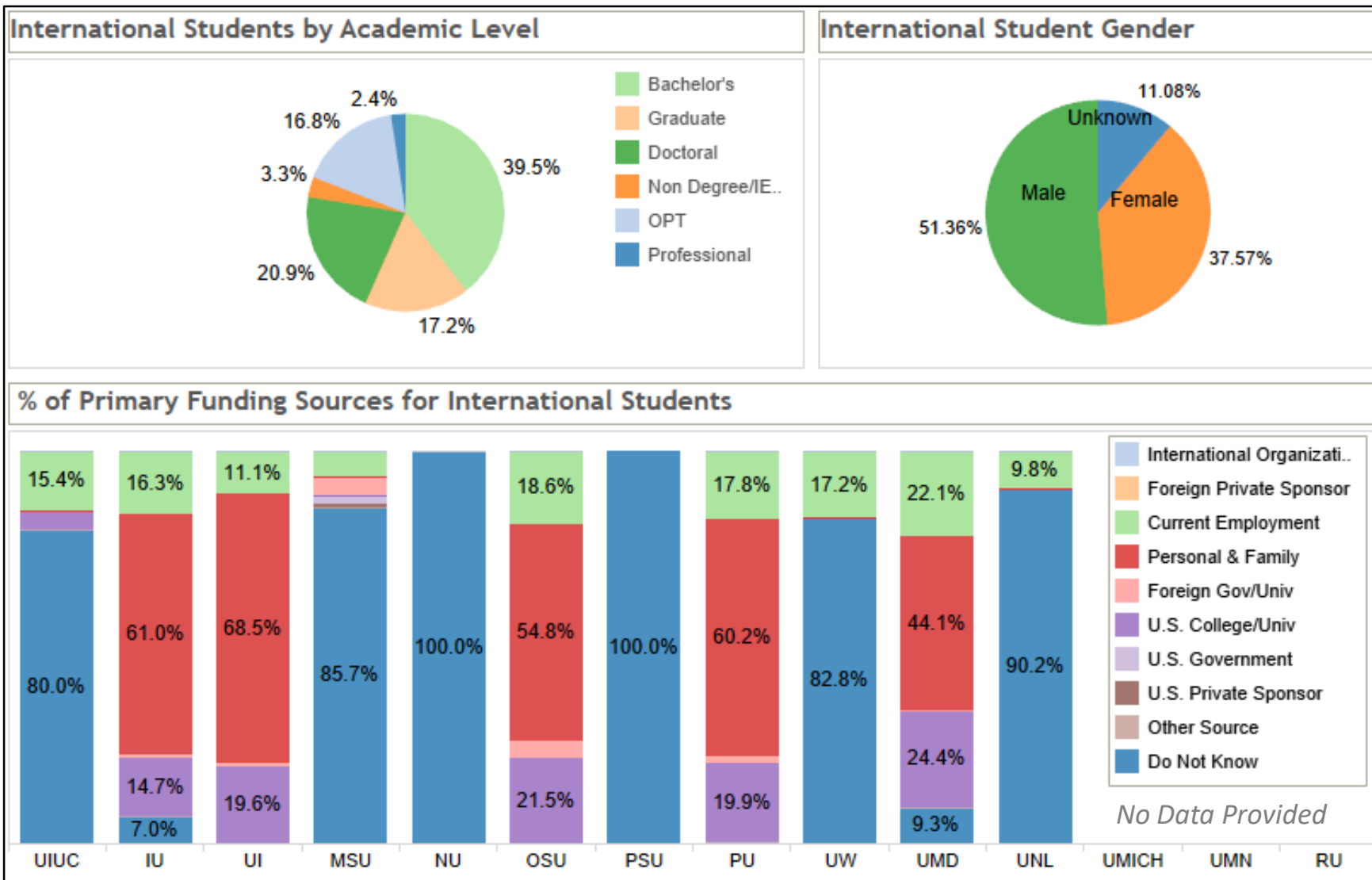
Enrolled International Students Fall 2016
