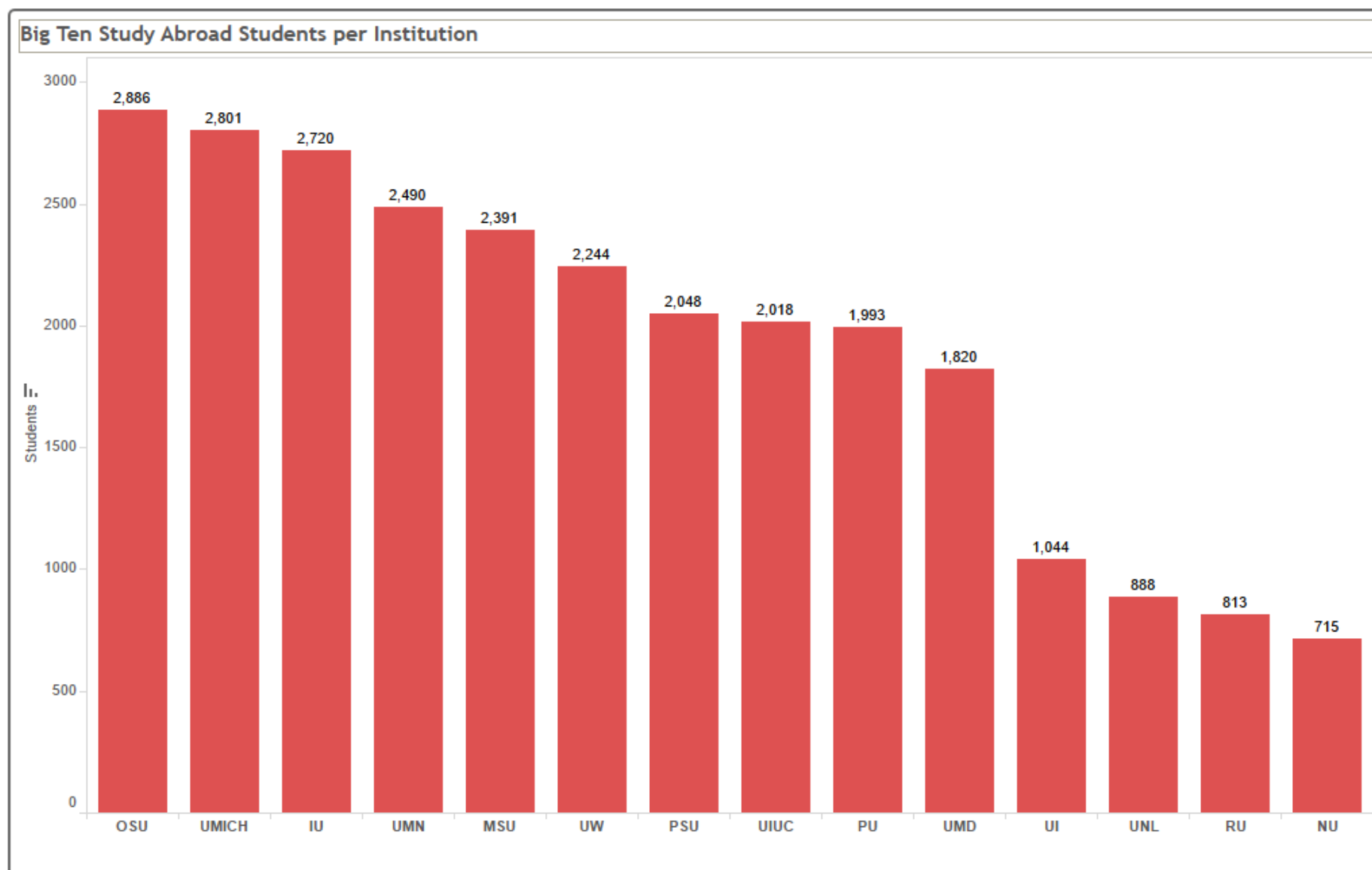
- **26,877** students from Big Ten schools participated in Study Abroad during Fall 2015 to Summer 2016.¹

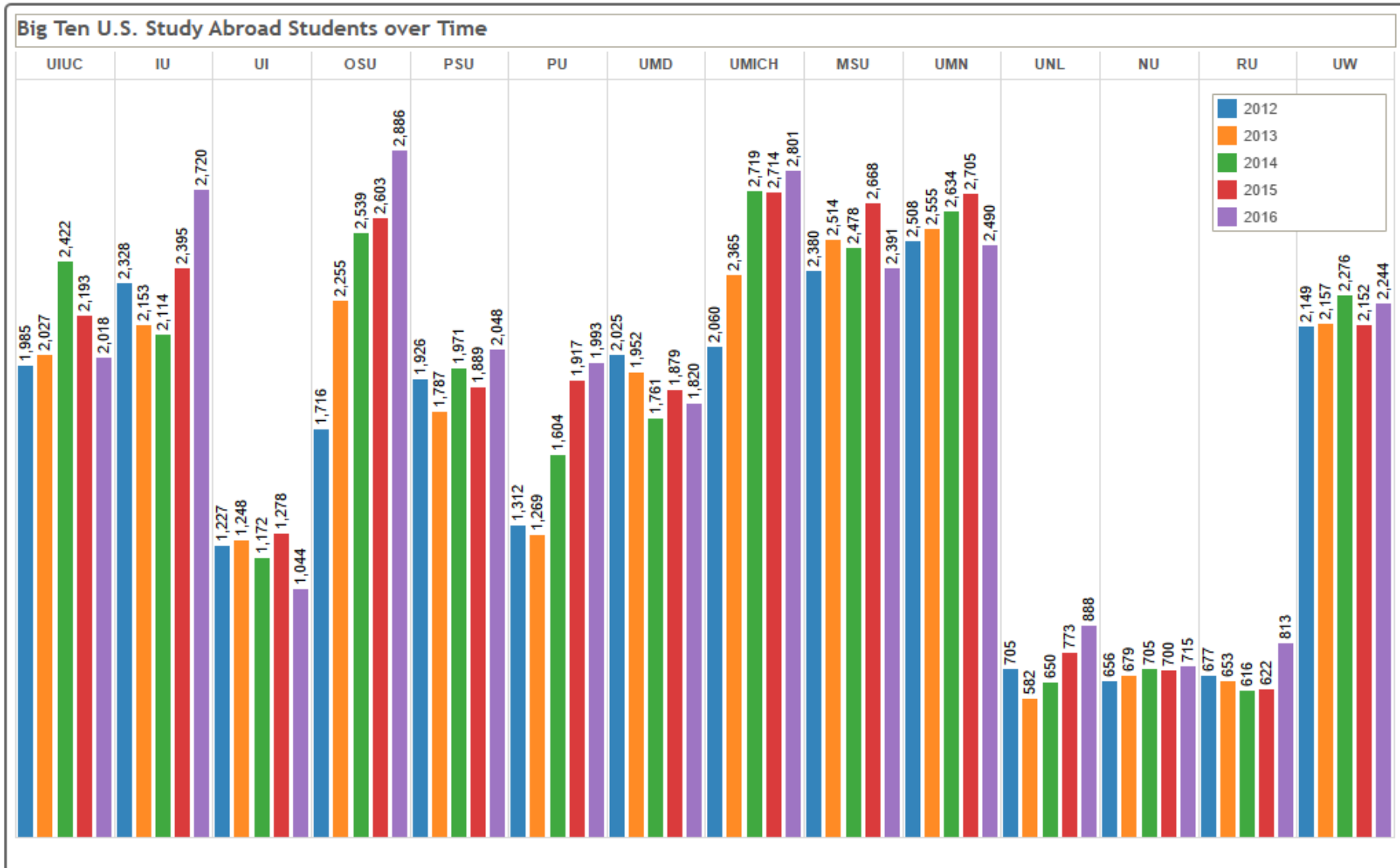
- The **Ohio State University, University of Michigan, and Indiana University** had the highest number of students participate in study abroad among Big Ten schools.
- The Top 3 Programs of Study for students studying abroad were **business, engineering, and social sciences**.
- The top destinations were the **United Kingdom, Spain, Italy, Australia, and China** making up about 40% of the total studying abroad from Big Ten schools.

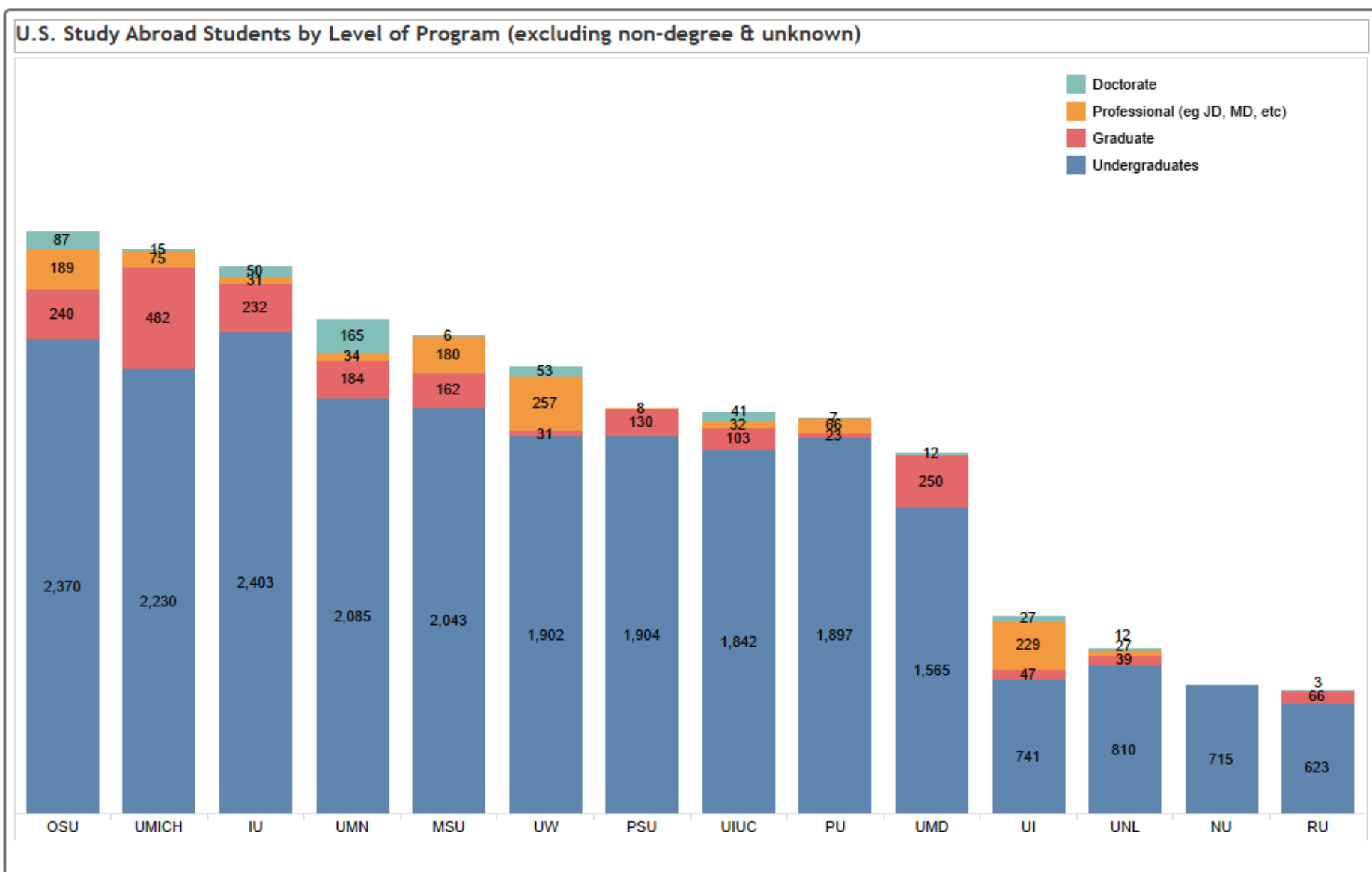
Study Abroad Participants by School Fall 2015-Summer 2016



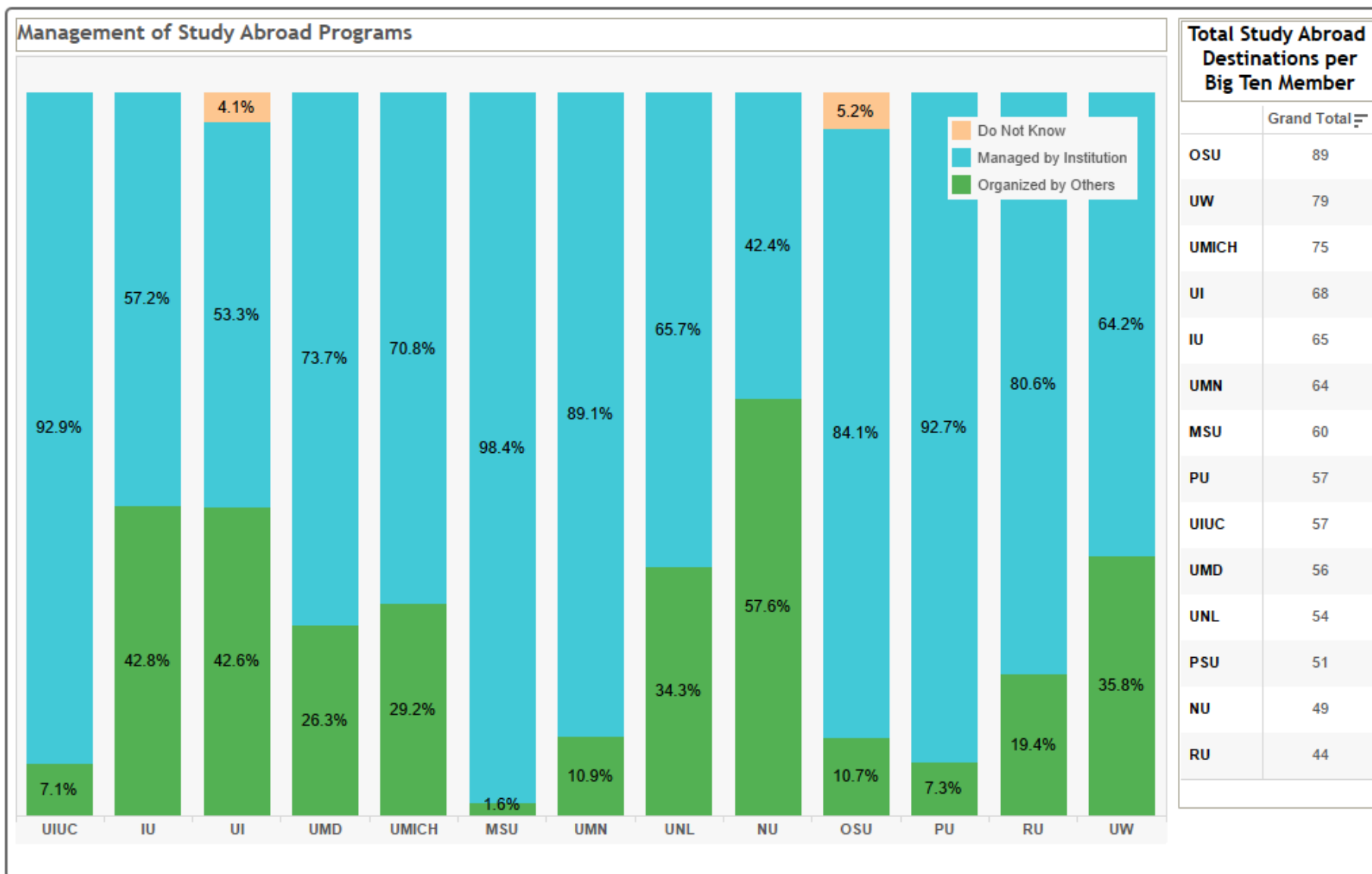
Study Abroad by Member Institution 2012-2016



Study Abroad Participants by School Fall 2015-Summer 2016



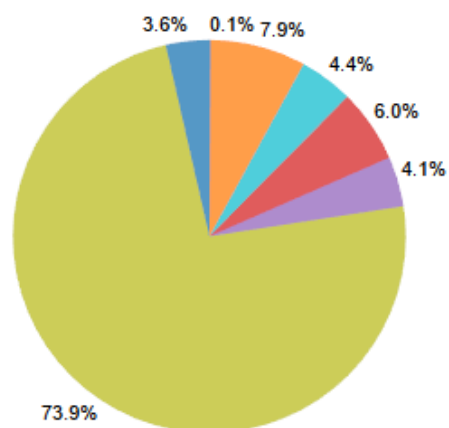
Management of Study Abroad Programs Fall 2015-Summer 2016



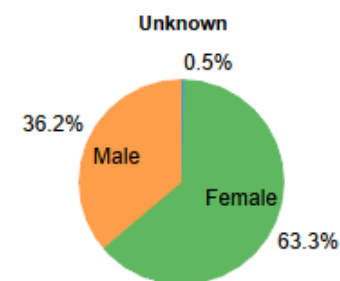

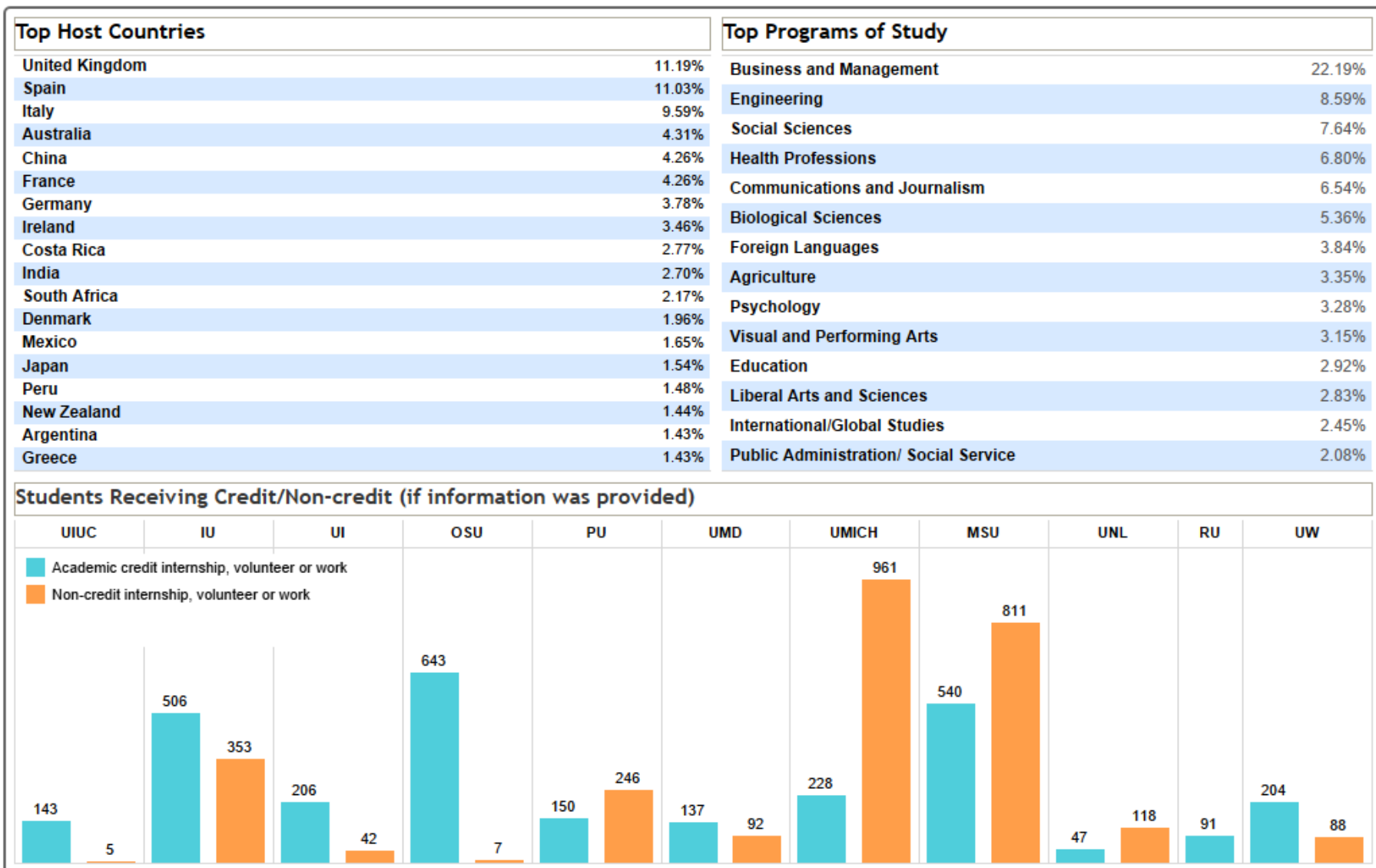
